Planned and supervised the on-time and on-budget completion of 100+ rig repair and upgrade projects valued up to \$50M, both in the shipyard and offshore. Organized the maintenance department and created statements of work (SOWs), developing repair budgets for ABS Class Surveys and assisting with the preparation of technical documentation. Inspected piping and structures and ensured welds met standards, preparing recommendations for repair or replacement as needed. Investigated procurement and construction issues, and collaborated with the engineering team to resolve technical problems. Supervised quality control programs and maintained a safe workplace with no recordable or lost time incidents.

- Created and completed the SOW, including removing and renewing 130 tons of steel from the shell and support, replacing 1,500 feet of lattice pipe in the legs and the jetting system, repairing onboard pressure tanks, installing new anodes, and painting the hull.
